If you are only able to show your car on Saturday or Sunday the registration fee is \$15.00, payable upon arrival. The one day package includes 2 adult 1-day entrance tickets, dash plaque, and entry into the two competitions of the selected day.

The competitions are not very serious so just giving your MG a “wash and a brush-up” before the show should suffice – the watch word here is fun.
